The Active Kids Rebate is a new initiative of the NSW Government, which came into effect on the 1st of January this year. Basically, it's a \$100 voucher for each child enrolled in school (ages 4.5-18), including home-school, to help offset the cost of sporting club fees. Each provider/club must be registered for their participants to be able to claim.

Keeping your mind healthy helps with keeping physically healthy and enjoying life to its fullest.

If you are struggling with your thoughts, emotions or behaviour, discuss it with your General Practitioner who can refer you as needed to the Clinical Psychologist at Grand Pacific Health Nowra or Shell Cove Family Health.

With a referral letter and Mental Health Care Plan from your General Practitioner, you can initially have up to 6 psychological therapy sessions bulk billed at Grand Pacific Health Nowra.

NSW Children – Free Influenza Vaccine

From April 2018 all NSW children aged from six months to under five years of age will be offered free influenza shots. Parents can access the free flu shot from their usual immunisation provider: their GP, Aboriginal Medical Service, community health centre or local council.

The flu shot will reduce your child's risk of influenza (flu), minimise the spread of flu and protect vulnerable groups including babies too young to receive the vaccine, those medically at risk and those with weakened immune systems.

Mental Health Care Plans

A mental health care plan is a plan for people with a mental health disorder that has been diagnosed by a doctor. If you have mental health issues, your doctor can write out this plan.

It identifies what type of health care you need, and spells out what you and your doctor have agreed you are aiming to achieve. It also may refer you to local mental health services.

You can get a Mental health care plan by visiting your doctor who will assess whether you have a mental disorder and whether you will benefit from a mental health treatment plan.

If you have a mental health care plan, you will be entitled to [Medicare](#) rebates for up to 10 individual or 10 group appointments with some [allied mental health services](#) in a year.

After the first 6 appointments, you need to see your doctor again for a mental health plan review and another referral.

The Mental Health Care Plan is part of the [Better Access to Psychiatrists, Psychologists and General Practitioners through the Medicare Benefits Schedule \(Better Access\)](#) initiative. This initiative aims to improve outcomes for people with a clinically-diagnosed mental disorder.
