- Cognitive Assessment
- Autism Assessment
- Combined Autism & Cognitive Assessment

In some circumstances, these assessments may support applications for funding (e.g. within the school or the NDIS) and can help inform appropriate support services in the community and at home.

Eligibility

Our clinicians can provide Autism and Cognitive assessments for people 6 years and over who have speaking language skills.

Medicare rebates

The service includes Medicare rebates to reduce the out-of-pocket costs where eligibility is met. This includes the Complex Neurodevelopmental Disorder Medicare Items. Better Access to Mental Health items (accessed within a Mental Health Treatment Plan) may be used under strict and limited circumstances, typically for post assessment counselling and support planning.

Assessment Results and Reporting

After completion of the final assessment a written report will be provided to the referring practitioner that outlines the assessment findings and any recommendations for future care.
